Purpose of Policy

Scope

This policy applies to individuals, including the Principal Investigator (*PI) and any other person regardless of title or position who is responsible for the purchasing, contracting, design, implementation, oversight, expenditures, or reporting of sponsored programs and funds on behalf of BC. This policy may include non-BC collaborators or non-BC consultants.

Definitions

Indirect Costs; Indirect costs are those costs that are not directly attributable to a specific project but are necessary for the overall operation of the institution. These costs are typically expressed as a percentage of the direct costs of the project.

Indirect Costs Waiver; An indirect cost waiver is a request for the institution to waive the application of indirect costs to a specific project. This is typically done for projects that are funded by certain federal agencies or for projects that are considered to be of high priority.
